Use this Net Control Script only at the EOC

Good Evening. It is 7:30 PM local time. This is: **K B 6 E O C** with YOUR FIRST NAME & CALLSIGN at the mike, at the Emergency Communications Center in Benicia convening the weekly combined net of the Benicia Amateur Radio Club, and Benicia ACS/RACES. This net is held each week at this time on the Benicia ACS repeater, KR6BEN on 442.750 Mhz with a PL of 100 Hertz.

(Unkey mic to let repeater cycle)

After the roll call, guests will be invited to check in with the net. Club activity reports, individual traffic and general announcements will follow rollcall. This is a formal directed net. To keep discussions orderly, please be acknowledged by Net Control before making any traffic transmissions.

Emergency or priority traffic may break in at any time.

Is there any emergency or priority traffic at this time? (Unkey mic)

Roll Call Follows. Please indicate if you have any traffic for the Net when you checkin....

Bring the rollcall roster forward and say: This is **K B 6 E O C** calling: (Then immediately call the first callsign on the rollcall roster page of member stations)

Upon Completion of RollCall ask:

Are there any missed or late Net Member stations?

Then ask: Are there any Guest or Visiting stations?

After all stations are checked in, allow those with traffic to proceed. Call each station, one at a time in order and ask them to proceed with their traffic.

Example:

W6XYZ, this is: **K B 6 E O C**, proceed with your traffic.

After all traffic is handled, ask:

Are there any late Checkins? (repeat after each checkin)

Does anyone else have traffic for the net? (repeat after each checkin)

When all business has been handled and the net needs to be terminated....

This net is held each week at this time on the Benicia ACS repeater, Kilo Romeo Six Bravo Echo November on 442.750 Mhz with a PL of 100 Hertz. (Unkey mic to let repeater cycle)

After the roll call, guests will be invited to check in with the net. Club activity reports, individual traffic and general announcements will follow rollcall. This is a formal directed net. To keep discussions orderly, please be acknowledged by Net Control before making any traffic transmissions.

Emergency or priority traffic may break in at any time.

Roll Call Follows. Please indicate if you have any traffic for the Net when you checkin. Additionally, in order to practice our communication skills, we encourage all stations to use the phonetic alphabet when appropriate....

Bring the rollcall roster forward and say: This is **YOUR CALLSIGN (Phonetically)** calling: (Then immediately call the first callsign on the rollcall roster page of member stations)

Upon Completion of RollCall ask:

Are there any missed or late Net Member stations?

Then ask: Are there any Guest or Visiting stations?

Kilo Golf Six Alpha Bravo Charlie, this is: **YOUR CALLSIGN, (Phonetically)** proceed with your traffic.
